<ol style="list-style-type: none"> Continue to encourage at least one member of each Sub-section to undertake the Advocacy Training and Development Program (ATDP), Welfare level one training. Establish a meaningful contact with the local hospital DVA hospital liaison officer for the purpose of visiting Navy Veterans in hospital. Record in meeting minutes under the heading of CARE, visitations to Navy Veterans in hospital or at home by Sub-section members. 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> Strengthen the presence of Navy Veterans at key commemoration services related to the Royal Australian Navy. Sections to ensure there is at least one significant service scheduled during the year remembering flagship events, such as: HMAShips Voyager; Yarra; Perth; AE1; and Armidale. In addition there is the Battle of the Coral Sea and Battle of Bitu Paka. Record in meeting minutes all attendance at commemoration services, particularly those relating to Navy. 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> Identify what specific support is able to be provided by each Sub-section closest to an ANC Training Ship. Encourage eligible Cadets and Instructors to join the NAA. This should also be extended to ANC Support Committees. Record in meeting minutes any activities that support ANC Training Ships. 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> Every member to solicit other like-minded individuals with an interest in Navy, particularly ex-Navy men and women to join their Sub-section. Initiate activities likely to draw the attention of younger Veterans to the NAA, such as engaging with Defence Community Organisation at their activities designed to bring Veterans and families together. Lobby like-minded groups to affiliate with NAA. 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> Ensure at least one member of each Section Executive and Sub-section Committee takes up the Administrator Website role and then assists their membership maximise the benefit of the Website. Encourage all members, particularly Treasurers to use electronic banking. Paypal is the preferred method as it minimises administrative effort. Encourage members who currently do not have an email address recorded with the National Registrar to do so.
