By-law 2.4 g.

Naval Association of Australia Commendation:

- (1) The purpose of National President's Commendation is to formally recognise specific meritorious acts of service to the Association by members, non-members or groups. Such commendations are separate from the Association's system of Awards as described in By-law 2.4.
- (2) A Committee or Executive of a Sub-section or Section may recommend the award of a Naval Association of Australia Commendation.
- (3) Such recommendation must include details of the meritorious acts which warrant the award, and must be submitted to the National Secretary.
- (4) If the National Council considers the recommendation to be worthy of a National President's Commendation, it must approve the award by ordinary resolution.
- (5) The National Secretary will prepare the Commendation certificate and forward it to the relevant Sub-section or Section Secretary for presentation.
